

## Sherlock's Beer List

**Duvel – Moortgat Brewery - 8.5% by volume** - has the complexity and depth of an ale, yet with the ease and refreshing nature of a pilsner. Light and crisp in color, flowery and soft-tasting. Triple fermented, twice in the brewery and once in the bottle to give that all round taste.

**Three Philosophers –Brewery Ommegang** - rich malty ale and cherry limbic, flavor of dark chocolate rich, ruby brew that weaves a port-like subtle fruit into a creamy elixir of chocolaty caramel effervescence.

**St. Bernardus - Brouwerij St. Bernardus NV – 10.5 % by volume** - The absolute top quality in the hierarchy of the St. Bernardus beers. It is also the beer with the highest alcohol content. A dark ivory colored beer with a high fermentation. Thanks to its soft and unconditionally genuine aroma, the beer can be smoothly tasted. The Abt 12 has a very fruity flavor.

**Peroni – 5.1% by volume** - This Italian lager has a very clean, malty taste. It is pale, straw gold in color. Exceptionally refreshing.

**Wittekerke - Bavik – 5% by volume** - smooth taste and a unique delicious aroma. A very pleasant drink, light in alcohol with a crisp and refreshing flavor. Take your time to enjoy it, you will find more flowery and spring flavors towards the end of your glass.

**Gouden Carolus – Brouwerij Het Anker - 9% by volume** - Its refined character, unique color, with a pure and rich taste, is captivating. It is matured at length in cellar and bottle, and is guaranteed to be brewed only from pale malts.

**Chimay – 9% by Volume** - Chimay is an authentic Trappist beer that is brewed within a Trappist monastery, under the control and responsibility of the monastic community. Fragrances of fresh yeast with a light, flowery rosy touch is especially pleasant. Its flavor only accentuates the pleasant sensations perceived in the aroma, while revealing a light but pleasant touch of roasted malt.

**Ommegang - Ommegang, - 8.5% by volume** - is inspired by the centuries-old brewing practices of the Belgian Trappist monks. This Burgundian style brew gives off a variety of aromas, including plum and cinnamon, and packs in flavors such as caramel, toffee, and liquorice.

**Boddingtons** - rich and creamy and slightly sweet English ale; you can sense a touch of honey, and it leaves you with a clean, pleasant aftertaste in your mouth. Low hop bitterness is present. A Creamy soft malt texture.

**Floris Framboise - Brouwerij Huyghe - 3.6% by volume** - Pours a deep hazy reddish violet brew with a fizzy dirty pink head. Sediment Aroma of powdered raspberries and spring flowers. Taste is highly carbonated, more raspberries, yeast and some candy sugar. Finish is slightly tart.

**Kwak - Brewery Bosteels - 8% by volume** - Discover a very mellow, fruity attack, a nougat-like solidity, and a slightly spicy character with hints of liquorice passing into a warm finish that reminds you of caramelized banana. The bitterness always remains in the background but in the end emerges delicately. You will smell a mellow, fruity and malty aroma with a slightly spicy character with hints of coriander, hops.
